

# Dr. Samuel F. Hampton

## Native Of Missouri

Dr. Samuel Farley Hampton, an optician, who maintained his offices at 22 Rector Street, New York City, died yesterday in his home, 90 Caryl Avenue. He was fifty-six years old and had suffered from a heart ailment for a year.

Born in St. Joseph, Mo., he was educated in the Dean Academy at Boston and the Fayetteville (N. C.) Academy. He obtained his professional degree at New York University and began his practice at the Rector Street address more than 30 years ago.

Dr. Hampton married the former Elsie Kay of Yonkers in the First Presbyterian Church here in 1918.

Besides his wife, he is survived by one daughter, Mrs. John Ward Prinkey, Jr., of Camp Hill, Pa.; one son, Lieutenant Wade Hampton, U. S. Army Transportation Corps, stationed at Camp Gordon Johnson, Pa., one sister, three brothers, and one grandchild.
