

MRS. HAMPTON ACQUITTED

Mrs. Olive B. Hampton, charged with the murder of her husband, J. W. Hampton on Oct. 5, was freed from custody at Anadarko last Saturday by Judge Ross Hume, on the grounds that the testimony of state witnesses failed to provide basis for a case.

The affair has aroused wide spread interest in this community as the circumstances incident to Hampton's death were of a nature calculated to throw strong suspicion on Mrs. Hampton.

It became known, however, that Hampton had been in the habit of taking aconite for heart trouble. Dr. Hobbs stated that he had sold him the drug regularly. The assumption is that, whether intentionally or otherwise, Hampton took an overdose causing his death.
