

CHARGED WITH POISON- ING HER HUSBAND.

Mrs. J. W. Hampton was arrested in Oklahoma City, Tuesday, charged with the murder of her husband, J. W. Hampton of Hinton, who was for years the police judge of Hinton, and who was found dead on the porch of his home there by neighbors on the morning of Oct. 25th. He had apparently been in good health, and in his bed was found a small bottle containing cough syrup. His wife from whom he had been separated had visited him and left on the train the evening before. An autopsy showed that the stomach of Hampton contained enough acconite to have caused the death of a dozen men. With the aid of the Oklahoma City police, Mrs. Hampton was located and placed under arrest and taken to Anadarko.
