

# Hampton Obituary

Joseph W. Hampton was born at St. Charles, Mo., Jan. 6, 1840, died Oct. 24, 1913 at Hinton, Okla., aged 73 years, 9 months and 18 days. There survives him his wife, four sons and five daughters.

Deceased was a member of the G. A. R., department of Oklahoma, having served as a private in company C., 5th. Missouri Cavalry.

The funeral services were conducted at the Christian church Sunday afternoon, Nov. 2, Rev. Chas. Thornton officiating. The members of the George Lambert post performed the last rites at the grave.
